RCA is a ministry of Riverside Church of Christ, Inc., a not-for-profit 501(c)3 corporation, established under a set of approved by-laws in which the Biblical principles that form the basis for the Christian teaching environment at RCA are listed. All employees shall, without reservation, subscribe to the following beliefs as listed in the RCA by-laws.

We believe that being a child of God entails living lives by the teachings of Jesus the Christ, the Son of the Most High God, as contained in the New Testament Scriptures. We believe that each individual has the ultimate responsibility for understanding and applying God's Word to his life. We believe that the Bible, as inspired by God, is inerrant and reveals God's will for man throughout history and the different Biblical covenants. Biblical principles, which form the basis for the Christian teaching environment at RCA, are:

- 1) That God is the Creator of heaven and earth and all that is in them; God is our creator; we are created in the image of God.
- 2) That even though created in the image of God, all of us sin and fall short of the glory of God.
- 3) That God loves us and has continually worked toward our redemption since sin first entered the world. That God's grace toward us springs from his love and desire for us, culminating in giving His only begotten son, Jesus the Christ, as an atoning sacrifice to reconcile us to Him.
- 4) That Jesus was born of a virgin and lived as a man.
- 5) That Jesus lived a sinless life.
- 6) That Jesus the Christ died on the cross, was buried, and arose from the grave.
- 7) That Jesus the Christ ascended into heaven. That Christ has been given all authority in heaven and earth; that Christ is on the right hand of God exalted.
- 8) That redemption is in Christ Jesus and only Him
- 9) That we are saved by grace through faith
- 10) That baptism (immersion) is for the remission of sins
- 11) That the assembly of church (eklesia) is a family working in love and patience to nurture the family and to serve as a light to the community
- 12) That Jesus the Christ will come again.
- 13) That all the dead will be resurrected and the then living changed. The Faithful to Life Eternal in heaven, all other the Condemnation of Hell
- 14) That God wants all men to be saved
- 15) That God's love for His children will never cease
- 16) That we should love the Lord our God with all our heart, mind, soul and understanding; that we should love our neighbor as ourselves.
